

Student Login Instructions

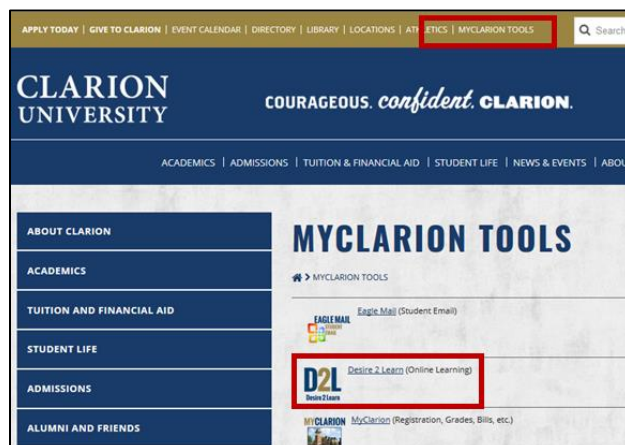
Log into D2L to access all Clarion University online courses. Use the login link found at www.clarion.edu/d2l. This page contains helpful resources for students for D2L and all instructional technologies used at Clarion University as well as important notifications regarding the D2L Learning Environment. Support numbers for D2L's 24 x 7 Help Desk and others can be found on this page as well.

D2L Username and Password Information

- **Getting Started**
 - a. **Change Password** - Before you can access D2L, you must initialize your student D2L account by resetting the temporary password assigned when you enrolled. Access the [password reset page](#) to change your password. If you already changed your password, jump to the [Login section](#).
- **Go to clarion.edu/d2l and click the Login icon**
 - a. Select the Clarion Student/Faculty/Staff button. Enter your D2L username (*s_username*) and password. This is the same username required to login to MyClarion, campus computers, and the wireless network.
 - b. Review our [Accounts](#) page if you do not know your username.
 - c. Remember, if you have not changed the temporary password found in the blue letter that you received when you enrolled, you must change it first.
- **Forgotten Password**
 - a. If you have registered your Secret Questions, go to the [password reset page](#).
 - b. If you do not remember the password for your Clarion username, you will need to contact the Computing Services Help Desk (814-393-2640) between 8:30-4:30 Monday-Friday and have it reset.

1. Go to clarion.edu/d2l to access the login link, OR navigate through the **MyClarion Tools** link in the gold bar across the top of the www.clarion.edu home page.



2. Select [**Clarion Students/Faculty/Staff**]

3. On the next screen
 - Enter your MyClarion username (you do not need to add @clarion.edu)
 - Enter your MyClarion password – (*note*: be sure you changed the temporary password provided when you first received your Clarion University username information via “blue letter” or email.)
 - Click the **Login** button

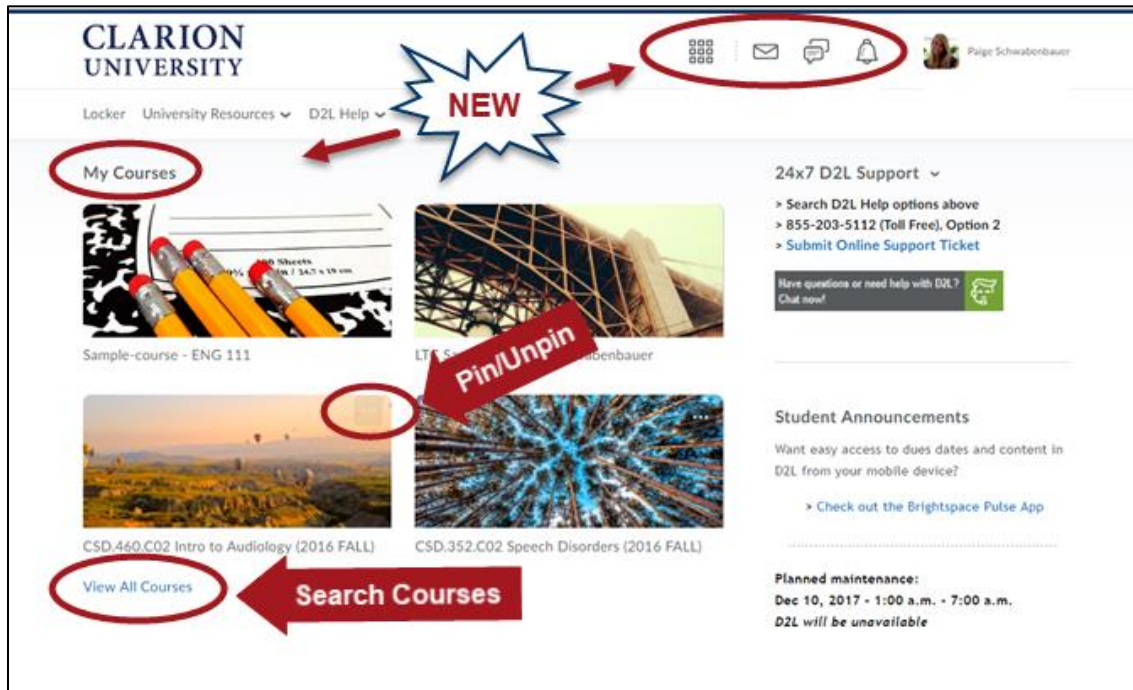
- Only enter your credentials if the web browser address begins with exactly <https://idp.clarion.edu/>

4. Access your course by doing one of the following:
 - a. **Click the tiled course selector** - Access your courses by clicking on the name of the course from the dropdown course selector at the top of the page. Use the Pin icon to the right of the course name to keep the course visible at the top of the list. The course selector is ordered alphabetically.

- b. **My Courses area** – On your My Home page, courses are displayed in the My Courses area with a course graphic and title. Use the 3-dot “actions” menu on the course graphic to Pin/Unpin courses from this area. In addition, you can search for courses by clicking the “View all Courses” link at the bottom left side of the screen.
