Faculty Author, Dr. Vasudeva Aravind, Speaks Friday



"Energy: A Practical Viewpoint" is the topic of Dr. Vasudeva Aravind, assistant professor of Physics, when he presents at the first Faculty Author Seminar of the semester.

The world is always hungry for energy in various forms. The present standard of living we enjoy would not be possible without energy from coal, natural gas, oil, nuclear reactors, etc. Considering dwindling

petroleum resources and their harmful environmental effects, we are now forced to look for alternative forms of energy.

Dr. Aravind's talk offers a perspective on the availability of energy resources, its usage in the present day context, and challenges to be overcome in harnessing alternative energy technologies.

Where can you find these journals?

Access most of them by going to the [Library Web page](#) and clicking on the [Journals/Magazines A-Z](#) link. There you can search for a specific title or browse the list by title or subject categories.

The [Databases A-Z](#) link provides information and access to all the databases the library subscribes to, and contains links to the majority of the journals available. Two databases that include thousands of academic journals and provide easy search access are *Academic Search Complete* and *ProQuest Direct*. Most other databases have a subject focus, which may be of interest to you too.

You may also use your ID card and Eagle Dollars to pay for computer printing.

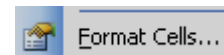
Computer Tip: Dress Up Those Column Headings

1. Select the range of cells that contain the column headings.
