D2L TIPS AND TRICKS

• Draft/Published? In D2L 10.2, the term "Draft" replaces the former use of "Hide/hidden". Don't confuse the setting of date restrictions for a future date as "hidden" content. If you date restrict an item in Content for a future date, students will still be able to see the link to the Content item, but not access it until it becomes available. This is a visual change from the previous version of D2L.

D2L 10.2 Frequently Asked Questions

With the recent upgrade to D2L 10.2, and especially the changes to the Content and Discussions areas, there are many nuances in 10.2 that have resulted in the following Frequently Asked Ouestions:

What happened to the "print" link in content?

The print link still appears in the upper right portion of the Classlist and Calendar tools in D2L. However, the upgraded Content area includes a new inline "document viewer" and the "print" link was removed and replaced with a "download" icon at the bottom of the document viewing frame as well as a "download button" More...

Can I change my Discussions view?

In D2L 10.2 there have been changes to the appearance of the default "Reading View" in the Discussions tool. The new Reading View shows stats on unread replies, replies and views for each post in a discussion topic. Users can also scroll through an entire thread on a single page. If you do not want to view Discussions in this way, the "Grid View" is still available. More...

What is "Send to Binder" ?

Throughout the Content area including "topic view", there is a new "Send to Binder" button. Binder is a mobile app for iPads or tablets which enables users to send a Content topic to their "Binder" for viewing on their mobile device outside of D2L, or for offline viewing. Instructors have the option to disable the Binder service for any Content item. More...

Can I use Internet Explorer 11 with D2L?

Internet Explorer 11 (released Nov. 7, 2013 for Win 7 users and Oct. 2013 in Win 8.1 update) is currently not supported in version 10.2 and users have called to report several D2L issues that were relative to IE 11. (View D2L technical requirements for recommended browsers) Some of the issues reported include, some MS Office 2013

• D2L Email Errors? If you attempt to send email from within a D2L course and receive an error, chances are you have checked "Disable pagers and alerts" in Quiz properties in a current or past course. Selecting this option is not an issue by itself, but if you 'attempt the Quiz' via Quiz Preview as an instructor, but do not submit the attempt, D2L will not permit you to use email via the classlist because D2L records the Preview as an 'attempt in progress'. Why hasn't my Collaborate recording (archive) processed yet?

If you conducted a live Collaborate session and recorded it, depending on length, the recorded session should become available in your D2L course within a reasonable amount of time. If 24 hours have passed and you still do not see the archive, chances are one or more of the session participants... More...

How can I launch a Collaborate session on my new Mac?

Mac users with OS 10.8.4 and newer are required to download a launcher to join a session in Blackboard Collaborate. Once the launcher is installed the session can be joined by clicking the meeting.collab file in the downloads folder. More...
