D2L 10.2 Upgrade Complete

On December 14, Clarion University and all of the PASSHE schools successfully completed an **upgrade from Desire2Learn version 10 to version 10.2** and D2L was up and running for winter intersession courses. Introductory videos are available for <u>faculty</u> and <u>students</u> to review the new Learning Environment layout. In addition, a web page highlights the changes and updated features.

The version changes were announced on the <u>D2L 10.2 Upgrade</u> <u>Features</u> web page in November and 11 training sessions were offered to introduce faculty to the new format.
