

On January 19, 2018, Clarion updated to the Daylight **Experience in our D2L environment.** The Davlight redesign includes new fonts, icons, colors and simpler formatting that will makes D2I more consistent for users across mobile and desktop devices.

D2L Daylight Facts:

>> All D2L courses were automatically updated to the new look >> The change was announced mid-November

>> A schedule was published announcing 22 building visits to preview the new design before the end of the Fall term

>> While the design is new, no tool changes were made >> The use of white space and simplified icons improves accessibility

>> The ability to add colors to widgets was depracated >> Faculty can still create custom homepages and add custom images for a unique course banner

>> Custom homepages that were active in a past course remain active when copied to a new course

What precipitated the design change and timing?

>> The design update is mandatory for all D2L clients

>> The Clarion academic schedule does not have a natural break for the update before D2L's cutoff time

>> More than half of the PASSHE schools already made the switch, including those with Clarion collaborative programs.

If you have Collaborate archives that you wish to retain, the Learning Technology Center will be contacting you with details about saving your recordings for use in future courses. Archives that have been made using the current Collaborate Ultra version, can be downloaded individually by faculty anytime. These downloads will be MP4s and may be uploaded to Mediasite for use in other courses.
