D2L Updates - December: My Courses Widget and Assignments Tool

Effective December 9, D2L users will notice several updates to the **My Courses** area on the D2L Home page and to the **Assignments** tool.

Highlights for the My Courses widget include:

- **Tabbed Semester View:** Courses grouped by term and pinned courses
- Smaller course tiles: Display start and end dates (if used)
- **Notification icons**: Link directly to new Assignments, Discussions, Quizzes

Highlights for Assignments include:

- **Updated layout:** Classic 'tabbed' view has been transformed into one screen
- **New 'annotation' feature:** Now instructors can annotate assignment submissions right in D2L. Highlight, comment, draw and more, directly on student submissions.

T.I.P - Tech in Practice

- **1.** Release Final Grades in D2L Watch this **2:25 video** to learn how to 'release' the Final Grade column in D2L. Final course grades are not visible to students until this step is completed.
- 2. Create a Quiz Template: Do you generally use the same quiz settings for online exams? Creating a 'quiz template' can be a time saver! Simply create a new quiz with all of the settings that are typically consistent: introduction message, submission view, auto grade, advanced properties such as 'Disable right click', number of attempts, and timing. Name it 'template'. Then, when creating a new exam, select copy from the "More Actions" button on the Manage Quizzes page. Select the template and give your exam a new name. Add your questions, edit date restrictions, and add the other essentials such as associated grade item, then Save.
- **3. RESPONDUS quiz question publishing:** If you typically use the Respondus application for quiz questions, you will not be able to publish directly to your course. Instead, *use the Respondus 'Export QTI' feature* to create a .zip file which can then be imported to D2L using the Import/Export/copy tool in Course Admin.

For randomized quizzes, export the QTI XML file as a 'Question Library' section. **See 'Export QTI XML' instructions (PDF)**.
