T.I.P - Tech in Practice

1. <u>VIDEO NOTE (PDF</u>): Closed captioning is now included with Video Note in D2L. What is Video Note? If you missed the training July 29, you can <u>view the recording</u>. You can use this built-in video tool for mini lectures, in addition to welcome messages, weekly overviews, and feedback.

2. BEST PRACTICE: D2L Hyperlinks to Zoom Cloud recordings: When linking a Zoom cloud recording in your D2L course, set link to 'open as external resource'. Chrome browser is causing links with media playback to show an error.

3. ZOOM LESSONS LEARNED: Quick tips for **Zoom** from our semester start-up experience (**PDF**).

4. ASSIGNMENT GRADER APP: The Assignment Grader App (for offline grading in the D2L Assignments tool) was recently removed from the app stores by D2L as it is no longer supported. D2L Assignment Grader had low usage across all customers and D2L has enhanced the web experience by developing an annotation feature driectly within D2L Assignments. Users who already have the Assignment Grader app can continue to use it, but product improvements will no longer be made. In the interim, Turnitin's Grademark tool, enables online mark-up. If you missed the training Aug. 5, you may **view the recording**, or <u>email LTC Support</u> for assistance.

5. RESPONDUS quiz question publishing: If you typically use the Respondus application for quiz questions, you will not be able to publish directly to your course. Instead, you can use the Respondus 'Export QTI' feature to create a .zip file which can then be imported to D2L using the Import/Export/copy tool in Course Admin. For randomized quizzes, export the QTI XML file as a 'Question Library' section. See 'Export QTI XML' instructions (PDF).
