interface that allows instructors to share, and publish new presentations easily. My Mediasite hosts the videos and has a Brightspace integration that enables faculty to embed video content directly within courses.



What's New in D2L

- Customize your Course Home page with Custom Widgets:
- Work to Do: Provide learners a summary of assigned learning activities that are overdue or have an upcoming due date in your course. The Work To Do widget displays the following learning activities: Assignments, Checklists, Content, Discussions, Surveys, Quizzes.

Learning activities only appear in the Work To Do widget when the activity has a defined due date or end date. By default, the widget displays activities due in the upcoming 2 weeks, and overdue work from the previous 12 weeks. Please see the FAQ for more information.



- **Ask a Librarian:** Add this widget to provide a direct link to 'Library References and Research Help' chat.
- **Activity Feed:** Similar to a social media feed, 'Activity Feed' is a widget that provides a central location for learners and instructors to post messages that are visible to the entire class. In addition, users can add attachments by copying and pasting a web link or embed code, or using the attachment icons. Notifications for Activity Feed appear in the Pulse App.
- Add files from One Drive Files stored in your One Drive space can be selected within D2L content > Upload File for easy addition to D2L courses. Files from One Drive can be attached in D2L Content, Assignments, and Activity Feed or inserted as a quick link using the html editor. Please review documentation for more information.

• **Assignments Evaluation and Brightspace Editor:** In *January*, D2L updated the Assignments tool in Brightspace. In *May*, Assignment updates continued with the roll-out of the revised <u>Assignments Evaluation panel</u>, including a new html editor. The new Evaluation panel will be *fully ON* effective with the August update. Please review the updates page for more information.

The **NEW** Brightspace editor will also be *fully ON* throughout the learning environment. Please take note of the changes as some icons have moved and may be obscure on smaller displays.

• **Discussions:** Updates to the Groups tool give instructors the ability to use D2L Discussions for private journaling between instructor and individual students. <u>PDF</u>
