

Study Abroad Financial Aid

Federal and state financial aid funds are available to students enrolled in qualifying study abroad, or exchange programs. Enrollment in a program of study abroad approved for credit by the home institution (Clarion University) may be considered enrollment in the home institution (Clarion University) for purposes of applying for federal student financial aid. Eligibility for financial aid programs is generally determined the same way it is for a student studying on campus at Clarion University.

Federal regulations prohibit students to receive federal and state aid for concurrent enrollment at multiple institutions. Federal loan limits still apply. If you are enrolled at Clarion University as a visiting student, you will not be eligible to receive financial aid at Clarion University.
