- 10-11 a.m. - Chat with a biology student, tour our research and teaching facilities, hear about student research, and meet with a biology faculty member.
- 11 a.m.-12 p.m. - Sit in on Principles of Biology (a required freshman biology course) or Cell Biology (a sophomore level biology course)
