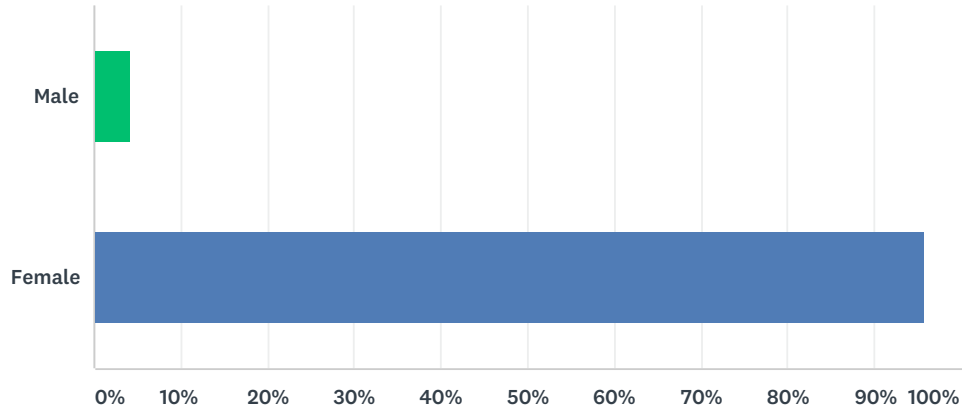

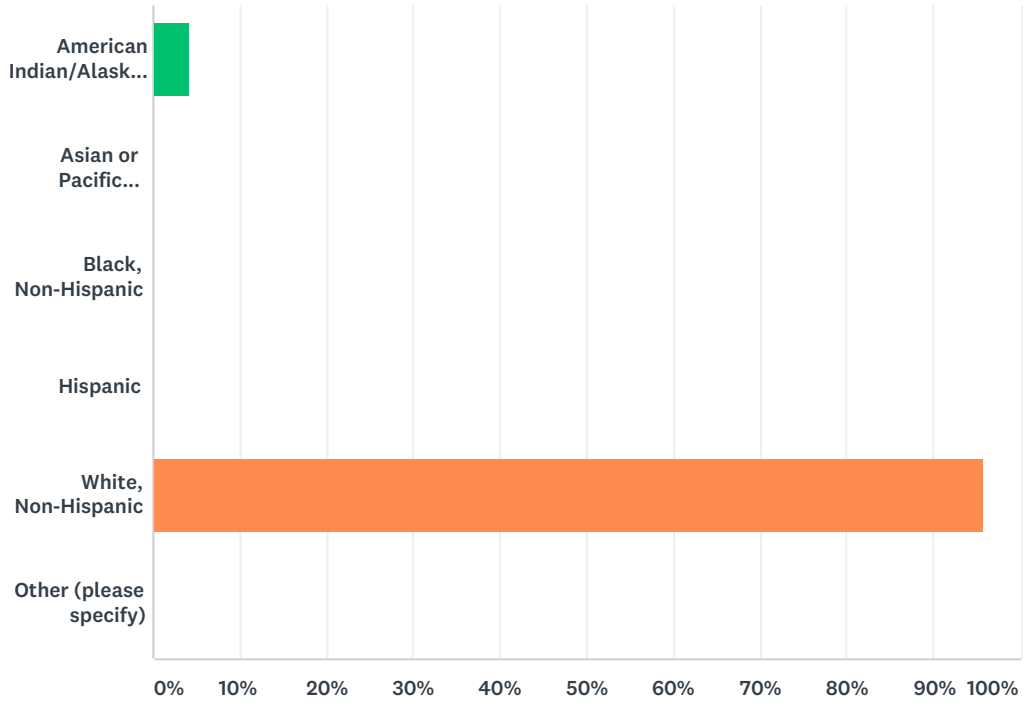

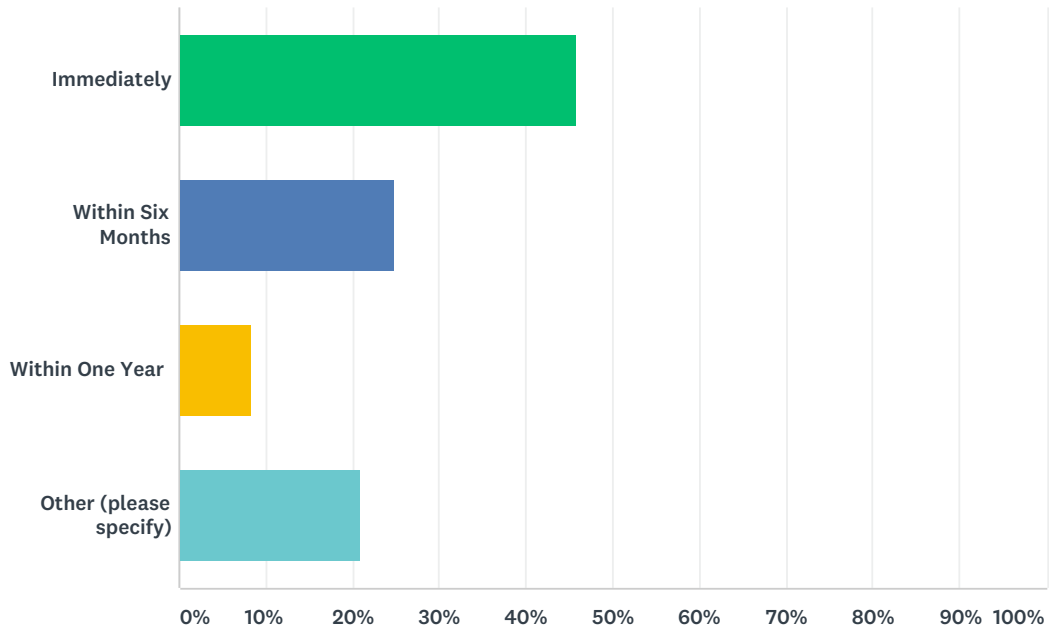

### Q8 How long did it take you to secure your first position after graduation?

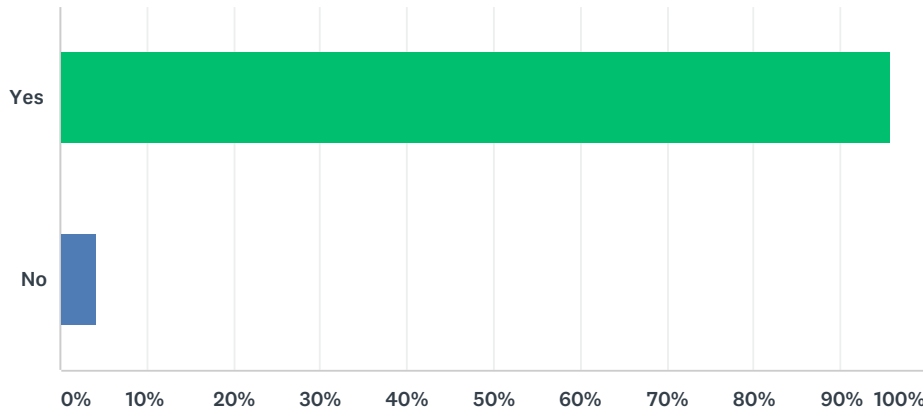

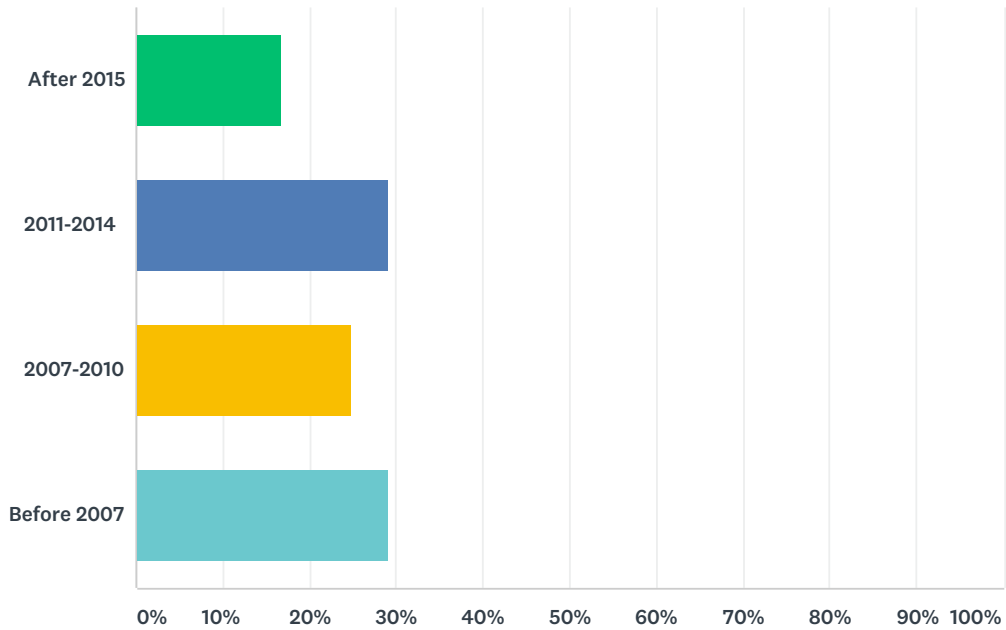

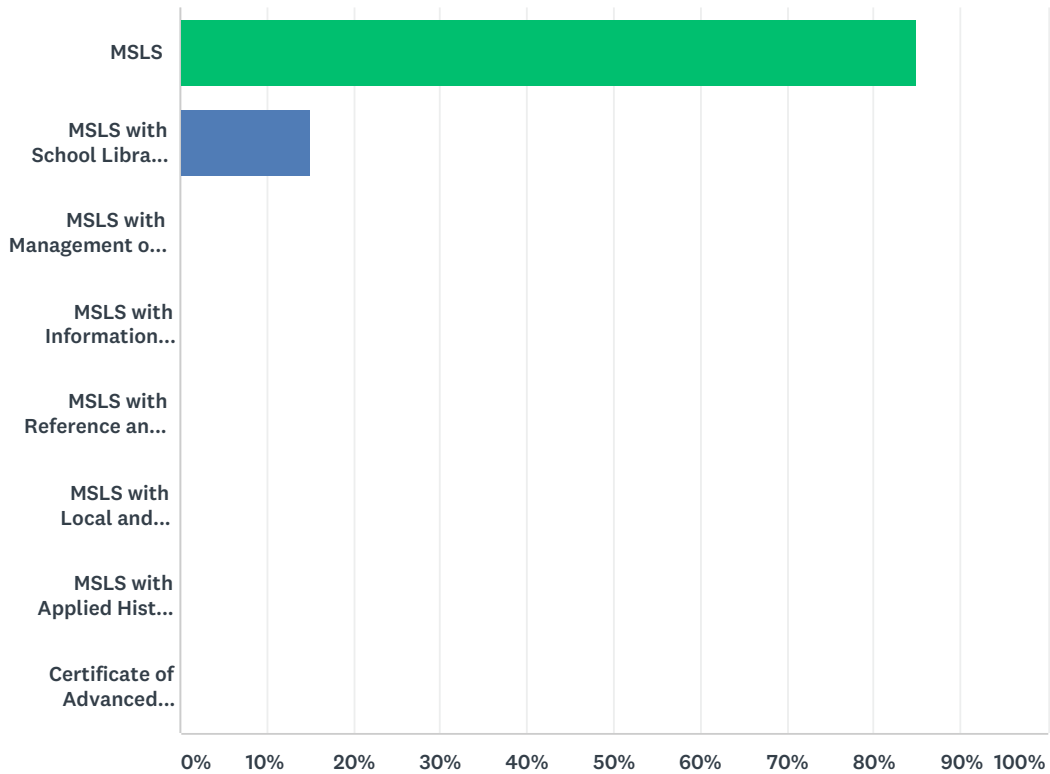

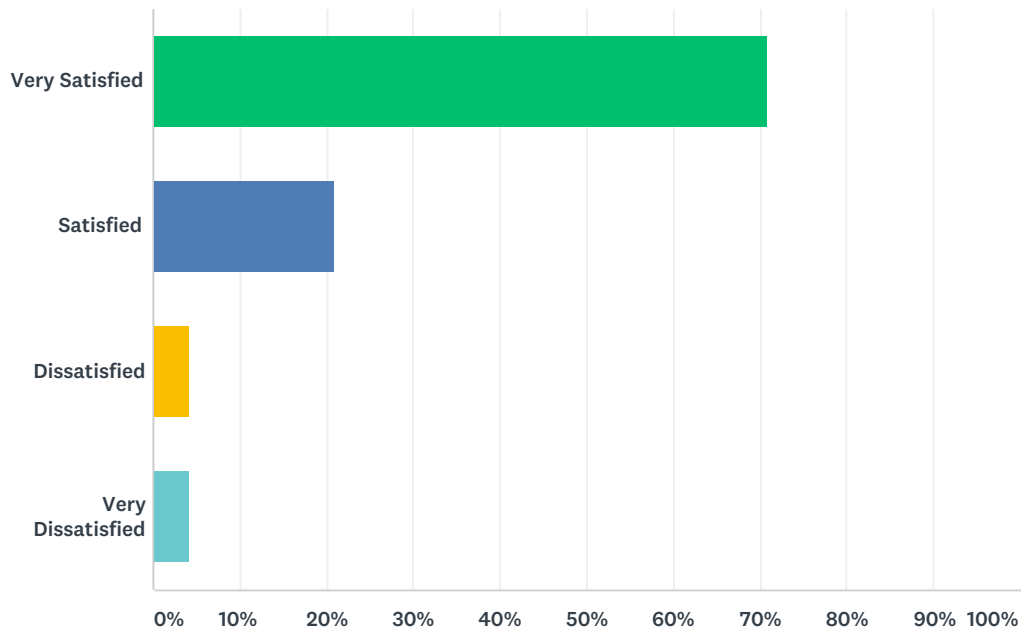

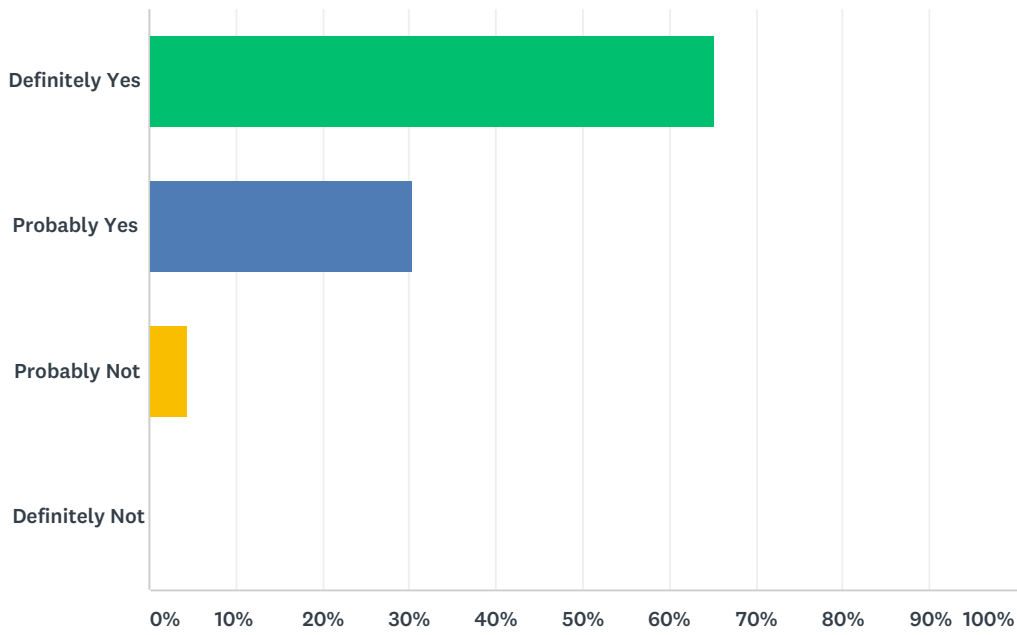

### Q14 If you could start college again, would you enroll at Clarion University?

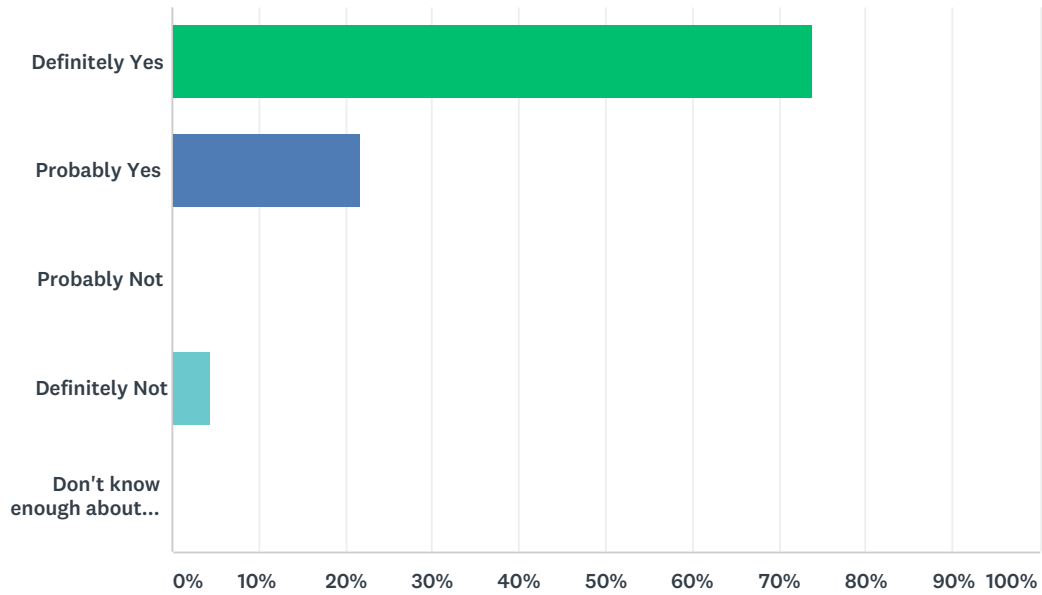

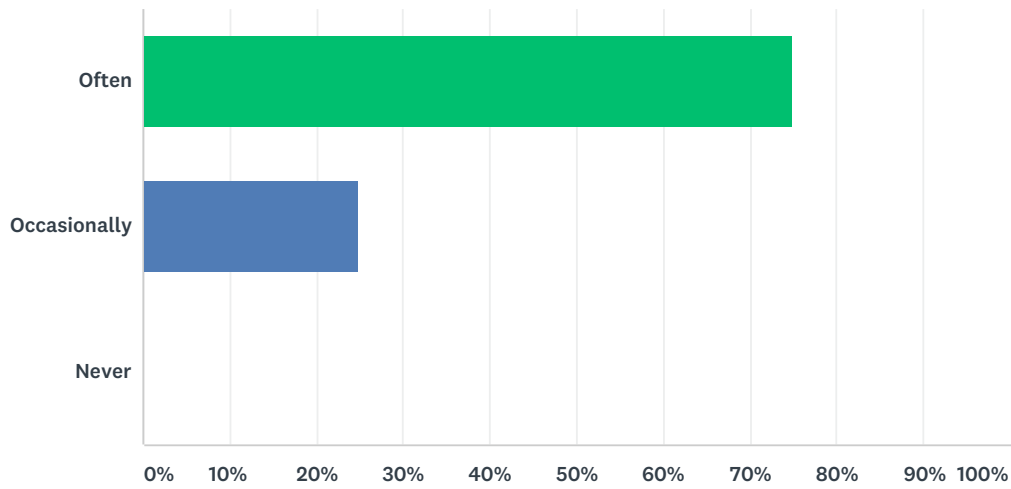

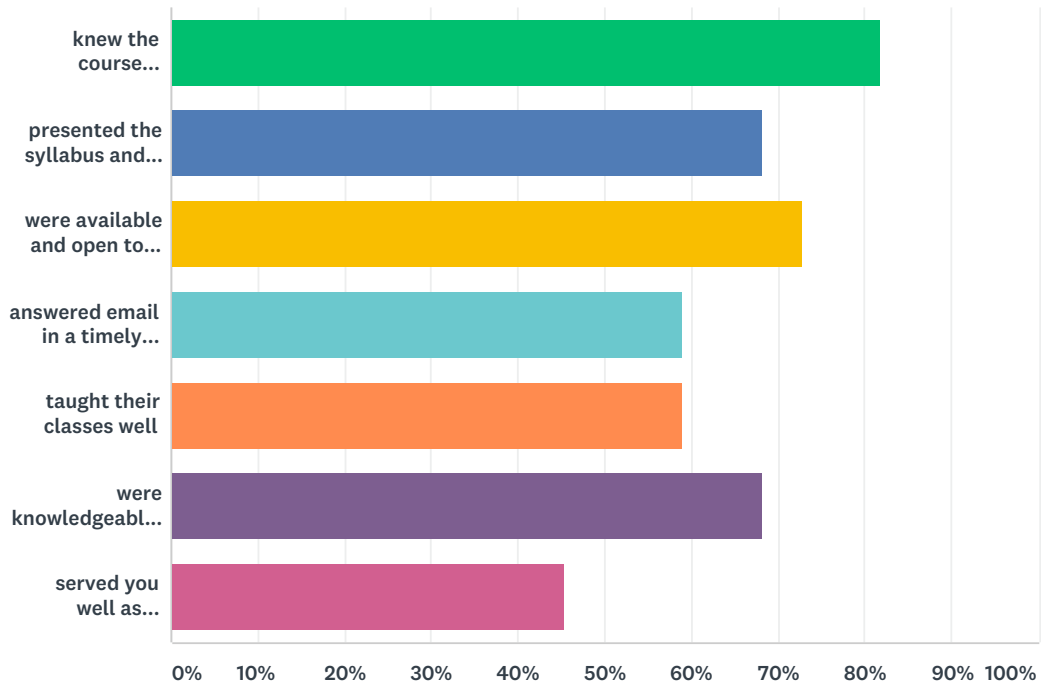

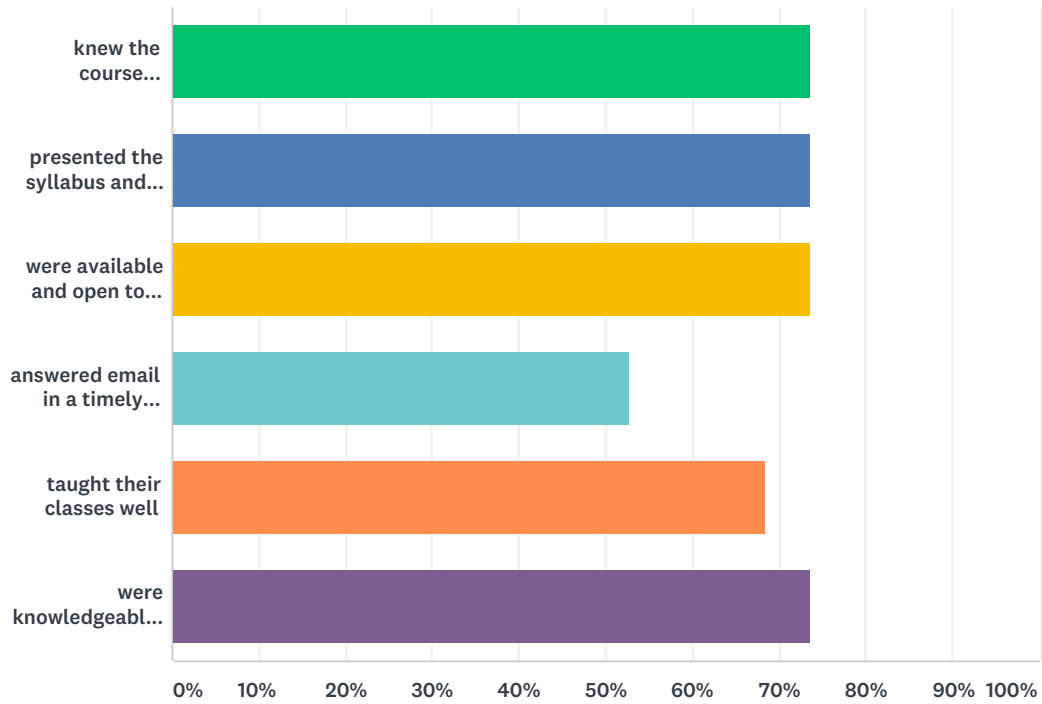
