Testing Information & Student Responsibilities

It is highly recommended that students discuss with their advisor any CLEP examination they plan to take, to ensure that the time and money for the exam(s) are not spent unnecessarily. As a rule, students may not substitute a CLEP examination for a course in their major coursework.

All CLEP examinations are administered as an Internet Based Test (IBT) at Clarion University – Venango, in Oil City. If reporting scores to Clarion University (any location), please designate Clarion University – Venango as your score recipient, regardless of what campus you attend/plan to attend.

EXAMS:

CLEP exams are typically administered at 9:00 am. All CLEP exams will take place in 311 Montgomery Hall (third floor), unless noted otherwise.

COST:

Administration Fee is \$20.00. This fee can be paid by cash, money order, or check (payable to Clarion University) on the day of the exam. This fee can be paid to the exam proctor.
